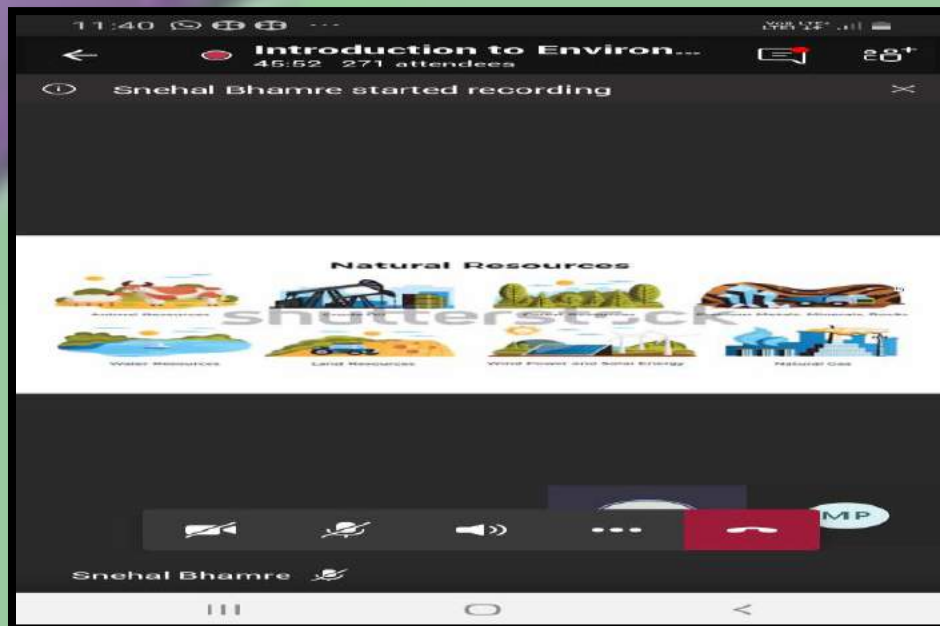

1. Expert talk on 'Introduction to Environmental Studies'

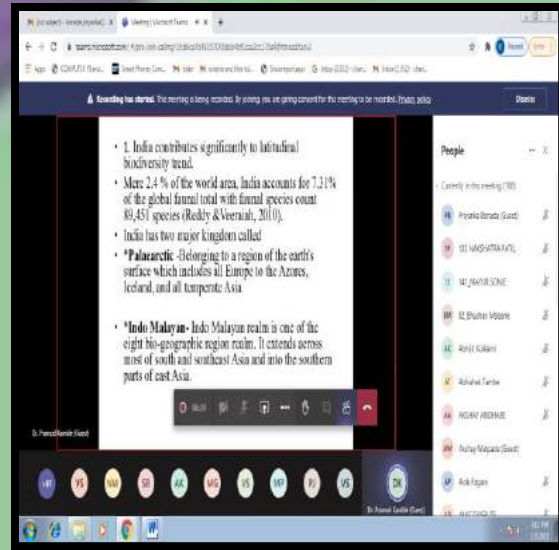
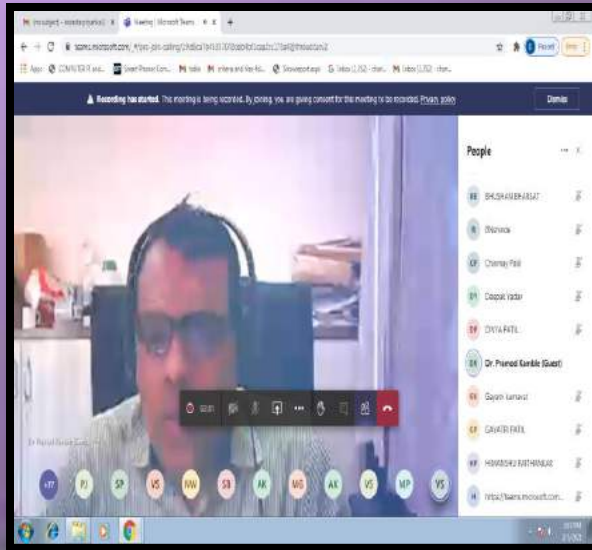

studies out of the same. He emphasized on learning objective with details about environment studies including natural resources, scope of environmental studies, importance of environment and need of public awareness towards environment.

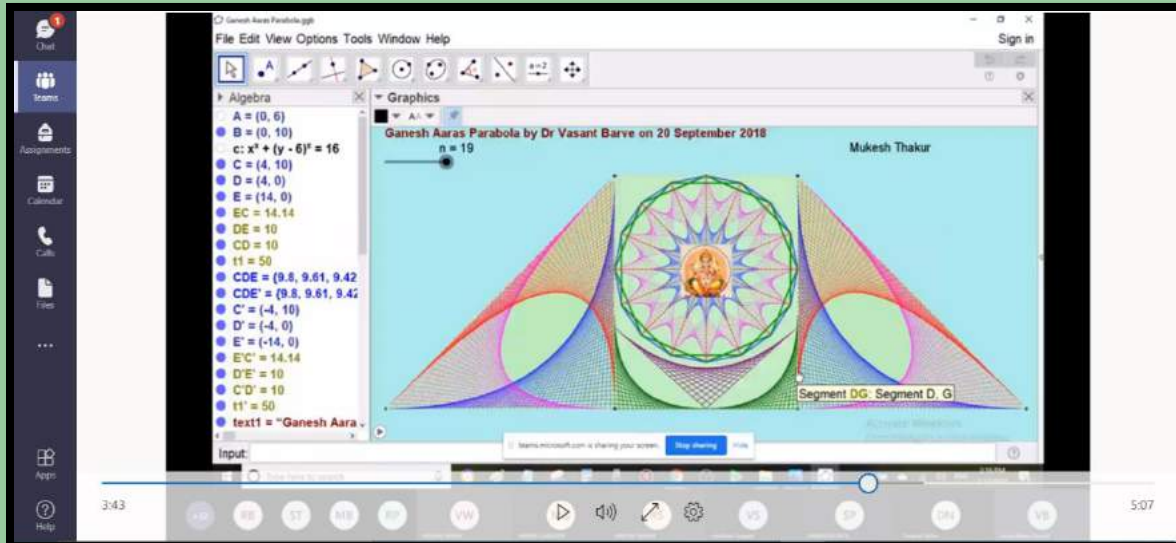


2. Expert talk on 'Biodiversity and Conservation'

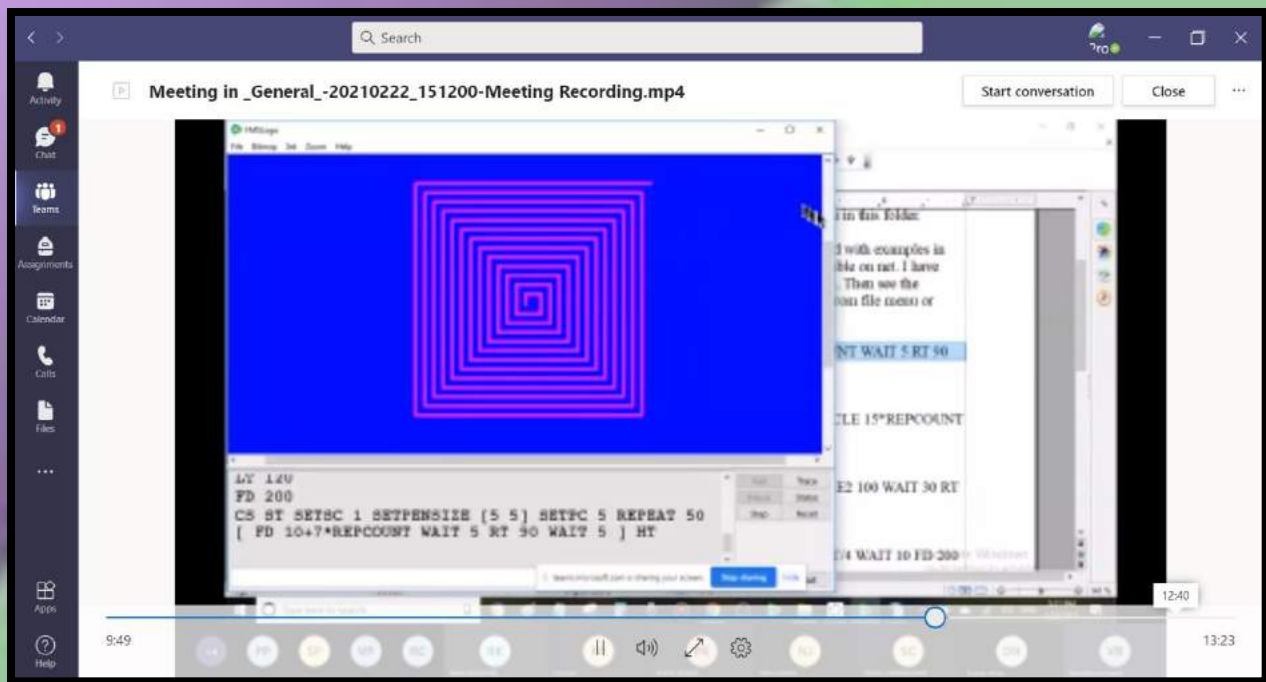

3. Mix Design Workshop for Second year students

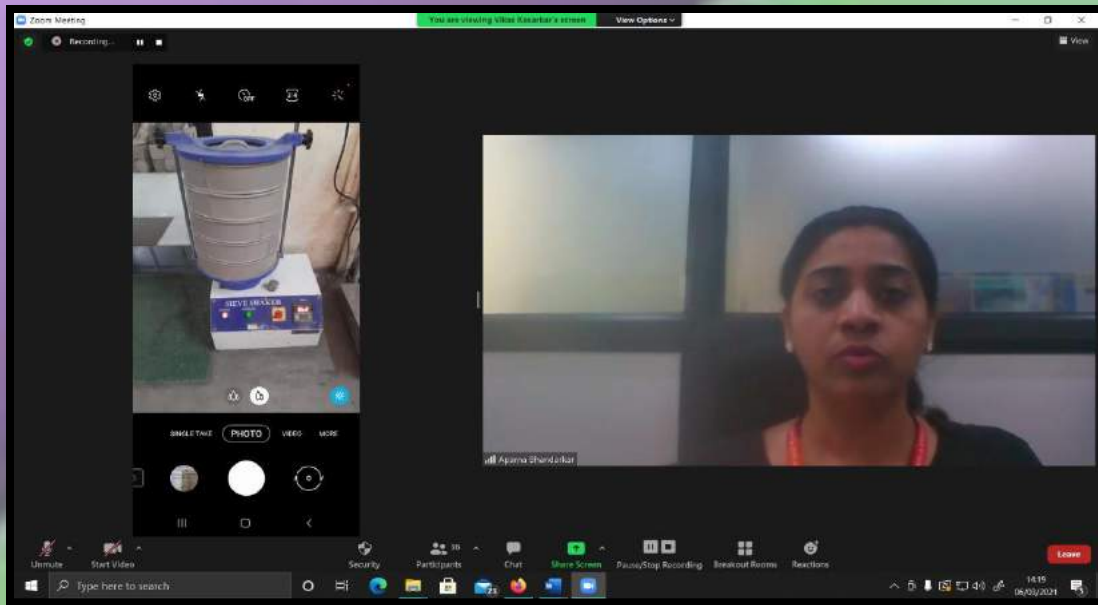
