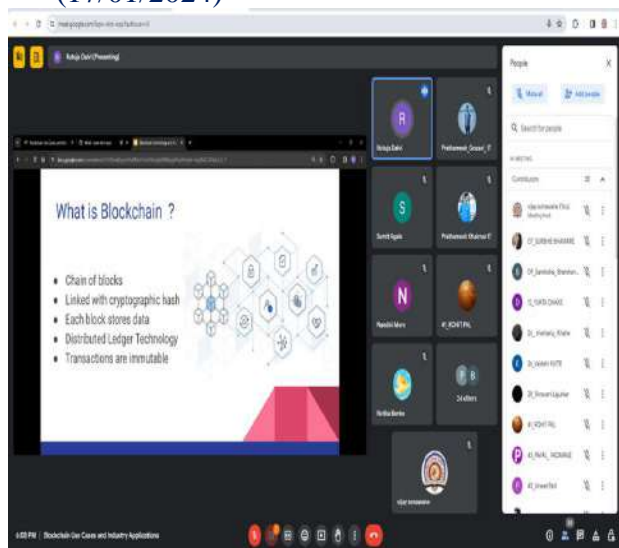
- "Cyber security in Edge Computing enabled Internet of Things" (14/01/2024)

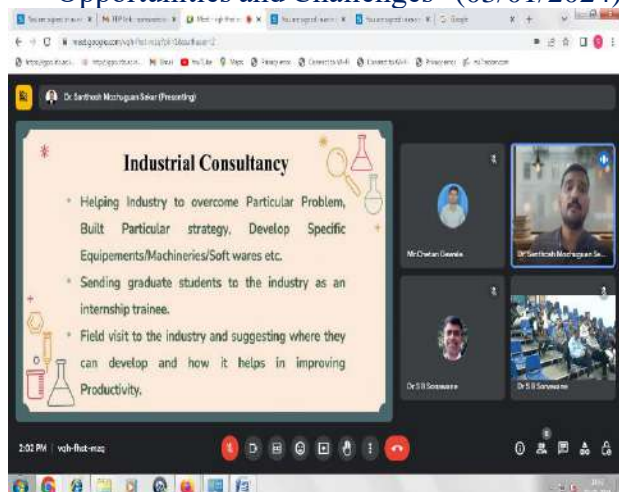
■ MSIC Competition (26/01/2024)
