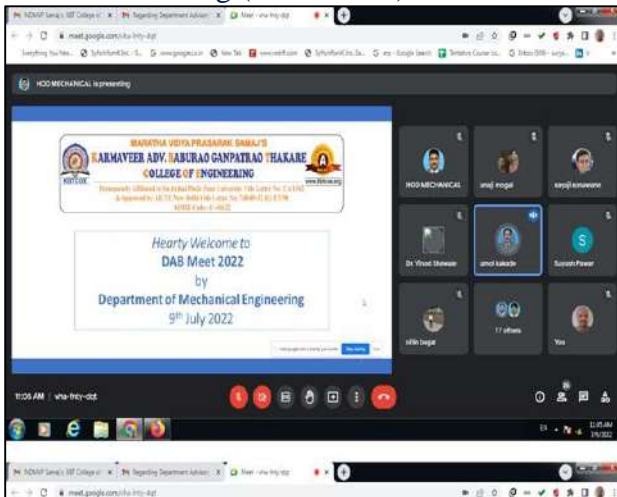
- TE & BE – Mech Students (28/07/2022)
