- Visit to Samsonite South Asia Pvt. Ltd., Gonde, Nashik (16/05/2022)



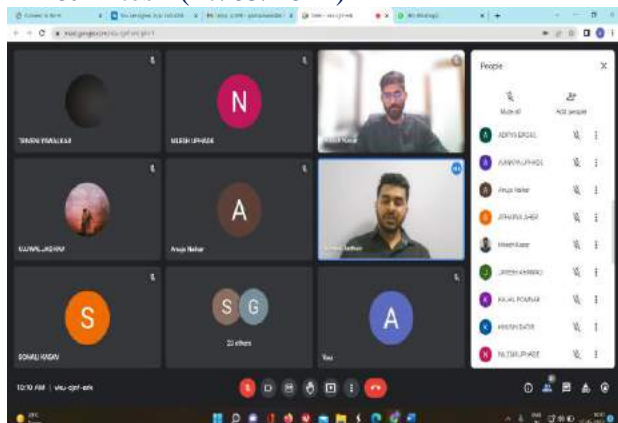
