5.6 Details of student counselling and career guidance

Mentor scheme is implemented by the institute for counseling of the students. A batch of around 20 students is assigned to one faculty who is designated as their mentor. He supervises the curricular and extracurricular performances of the students and keeps good rapport with them as well as their parents. Some of the major features of the mentor scheme are as follows:

Academic:

The mentor scheme serves as a platform for counselling for weak students. The mentor is expected to know the strengths and weaknesses of individuals assigned to him and suggest the remedies to win over the shortcomings. Since, the numbers of students assigned to a mentor are limited; each one will get personal attention on his academic performances.

Personal:

The mentors act as true guardians for the students assigned to them. The mentees can share their personal problems and difficulties with the mentor who can assist them in deriving solutions for the same. Here also, the one to one contact has a significant effect.

Best Practices

Title of the practice:

Providing training to the students through industry based training centres.

Goal:

1. To prepare competent professionals for industries .
2. To enhance skill in line with recent industrial practices.
3. To improve intra personal skills like analysis, decision, leadership, confidence, communication, and discipline.

The context:

To increase the practical exposure of students that will help them to get place in industries at the earliest.

The practice: Faculties from industries like Fox Solutions, strama summit, IFS academy, winjit etc. come to the institute. They conduct theory and practical sessions (Approximate 70% Practical and 30% theory) Faculties do give assignments to students. Students solve the assignments in a time period of three to four days. Students are then evaluated on the basis of written test.

Evidence of Success:

1. Enhancement in students campus recruitments
2. Students from other Engineering colleges are getting enrolled
3. Improvements in intrapersonal skills of students

Problems encountered and resources required:

1. Time management of curriculum and training sessions.
2. Students attrition rate is very high (Students are not ready to grab opportunities at comparatively lower salaries and they leave the jobs very fast).
3. Establishing practical approach amongst the faculty to bridge industry expectations

Title of the practice: Village Adaption Program

The Village Adoption study provides an opportunity to understand the factors that are responsible for under-development in a village. They also get familiar with the interventions, participatory interactions, understanding the prevailing situation, mobilization of community, initiate participatory processes, establishing linkages among line departments etc. which are likely to strengthen the process of development and ensure poverty reduction and strengthen natural resources management. The process of Village Adoption is thus an experimentation and involvement of Students & faculty members to drive the process of development in a selected village. Given the emphasis on involvement of faculty members at grass-root level by adopting specific village, preferably from back-ward area, as well as keeping the experience of first phase of Village Adoption studies, it is felt necessary to draw a frame-work while undertaking this category of studies. Consequently, the broad guidelines are evolved. The village adoption study envisages integrated and holistic development of village or cluster of villages selected on a micro/macro watershed basis, on an Action Research mode. The village adoption provides an opportunity to academicians, policy makers and civil society, to get sensitized and understand the problems and social dynamics that exist at the grass root level and assimilate the facilitating factors responsible for building sustainable and cohesive communities through inspiring, igniting, educating and enabling them to develop by utilising multiple opportunities with special focus on disadvantaged sector. The village adoption will also empower the faculty for better training, research and thus rural development.

Goals:

Village Adoption program is to equip and familiarize the faculty & students, with the socioeconomic dimensions of the rural communities, status of sustainable use of natural resources, changing perceptions & aspirations, priorities and innovative effort of the rural communities for sustainable development and inspire the community for self-help to roll out strategies, processes to develop sustainably and create cohesive communities where every individual gets equal opportunity to realize their potential.

Through this process the faculty learn, document the ups and downs of the process which can help them in revising strategies for better training and come up with new models of rural development for replication elsewhere by all stakeholders.

The Context

- To generate awareness on gender issues and social issues like literacy, health & hygiene, sanitation, safe drinking water, livelihood options etc.
- To encourage large scale adoption of improved technologies.
- Economic empowerment of resource poor farmers.
- To enhance and ensure of financial literacy.
- Students learn to contribute towards “Nation Building”.
- To encourage the education knowledge among the students and living people.
- By this program, students conduct various social & educational activities for school students.
