- First Year Engineering Students Association (AARAMBH) organized a workshop on "Arduino UNO". For delivering the content Mr. Swapnil Rajguru (SwA Innovations, Nashik), Mr. Ashish Ugale (SwA Innovations, Nashik) & Team was invited.
- Workshop started with presentation of Mr. Ashish Ugale on basic Electronics and then he introduced students about microcontroller and Arduino circuit. He also stated that Arduino Uno is an open-source microcontroller board based on the Microchip ATmega328P microcontroller and developed by Arduino.cc. he board is equipped with sets of digital and analog input/output (I/O) pins that may be interfaced to various expansion boards and different sensors. Later Mr. Swapnil Rajguru and his team guided students about how to interface all elements with Arduino circuit and students have run various hands on practicals like led blinking, temperature sensing, buzzer, relay operation, LCD display etc.
- Total around 80 students were participated in the workshop which is divided in two session morning 8.30 to 11.30am and afternoon 12.30 to 3.30pm.
