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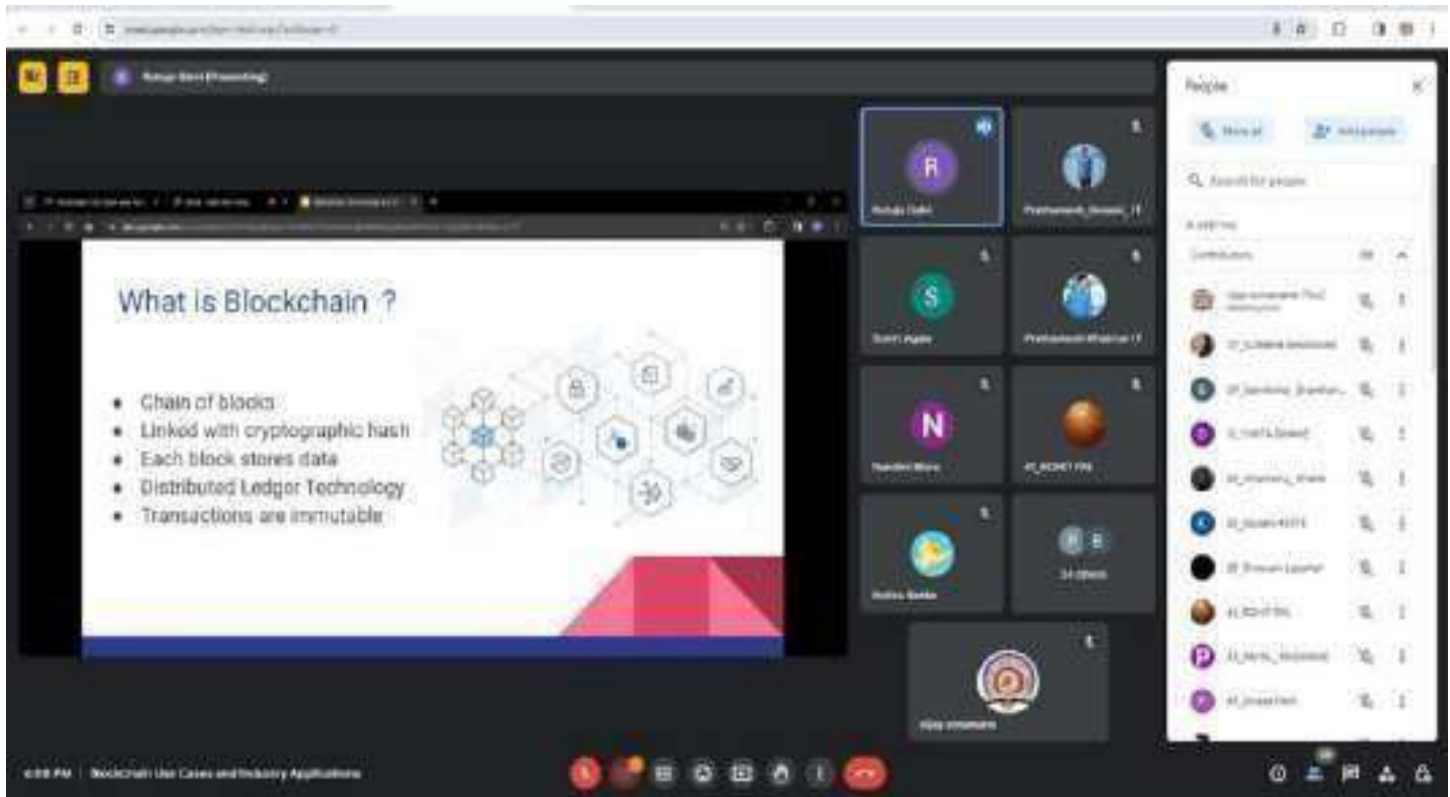

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05 - Days Workshop on "Data Analytics using cloud"

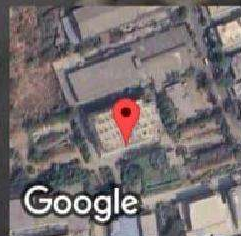

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workshop seminar on " Cyber security in Edge Computing enabled Internet of Things"

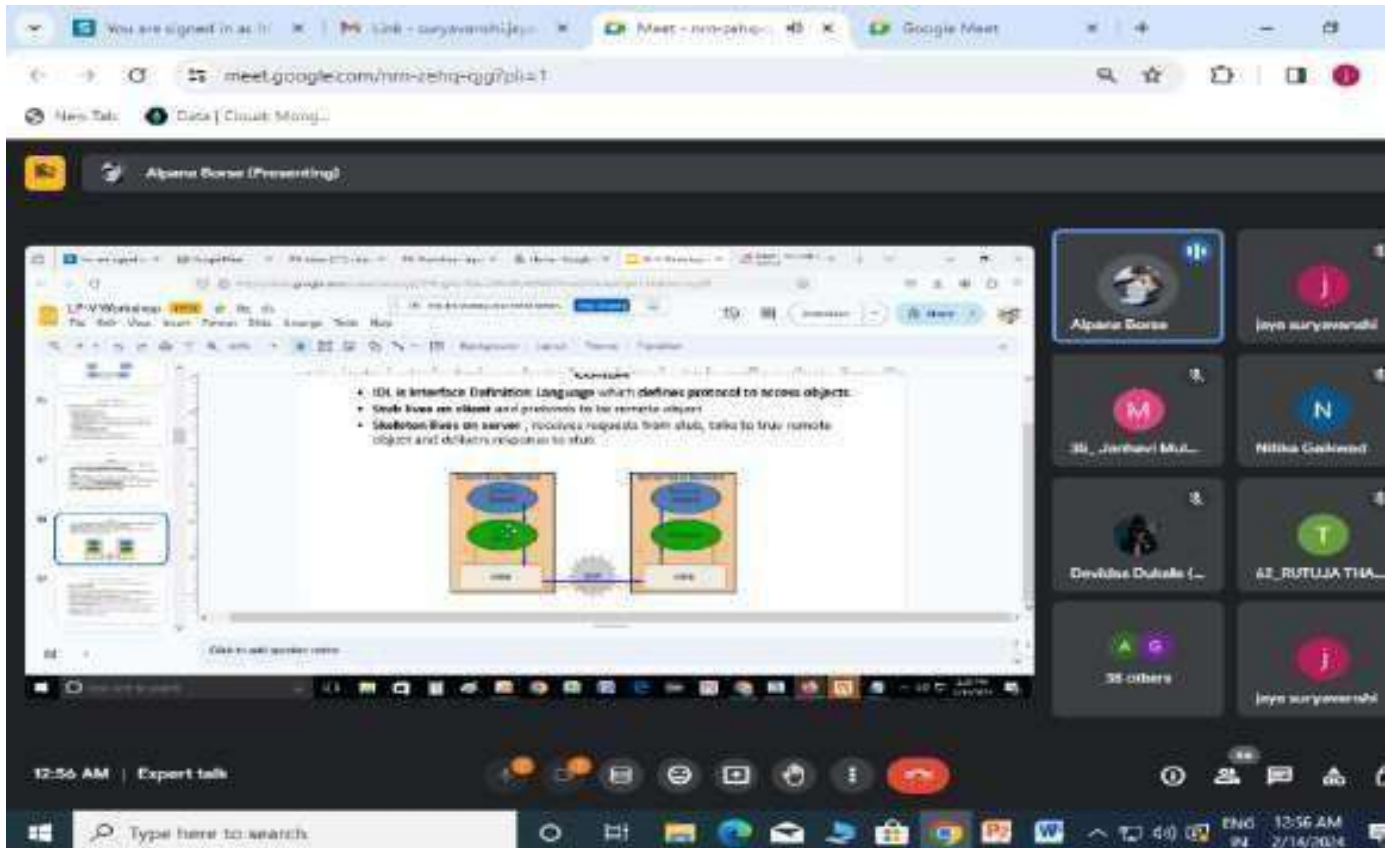

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NSS River Conservation and Sanitation Drive



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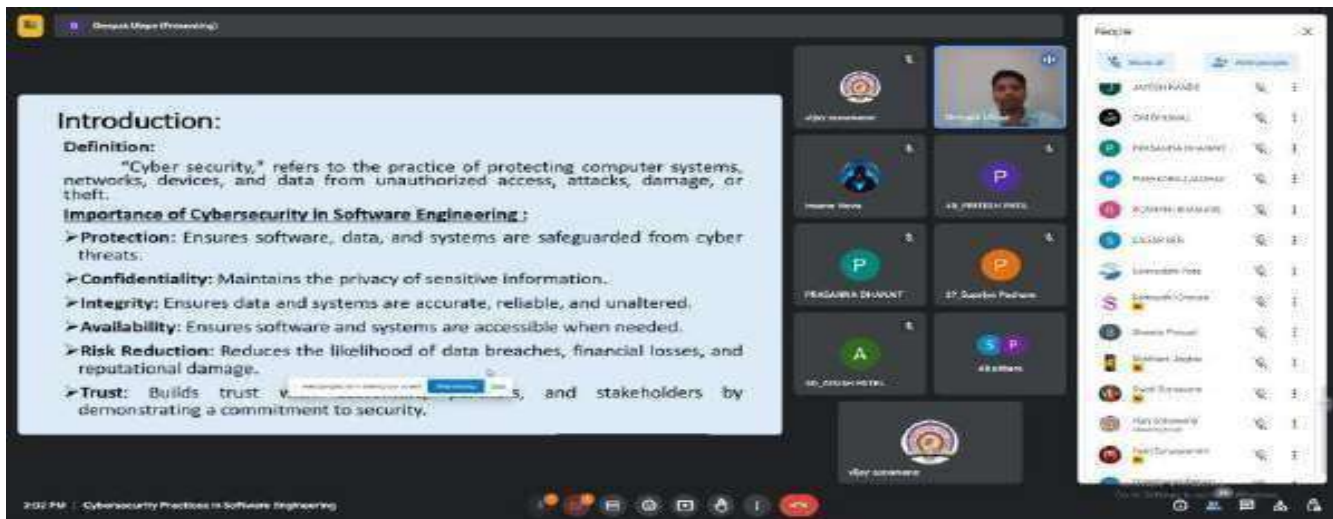
