Following points are discussed in the meeting:

- 1) It is decided in the BOS meeting to change the name of subject “Manufacturing workshop practice”. It is to be kept only Workshop Practice”.
- 2) The tutorials for Workshop practices has been revised as per following suggestions:
 - a) Shopfloor safety, electrical safety and the safety related tutorial should be compulsory to all disciplines.
 - b) Use of measuring instruments should be taught to the students of every discipline.
 - c) Carpentry job should be mandatory to the students of all the disciplines.
 - d) Tutorial related to Electrical and Electronic components should be mandatory for Mechanical and Civil Engineering students.
 - e) Tutorials which include CNC programming, 3-D printing and plumbing should be mandatory to all soft branches.
- 3) It is decided to frame the exit policy for the students willing to exit after completing first year programme. Also it is decided to identify skill courses, internship relevant to Mechanical Engineering discipline which can provide additional credits required for UG certificate.
- 4) Curriculum structuring of B.Tech and M.Tech are approved.
- 5) Detailed syllabus of First year B.Tech. course relevant to Mechanical Engineering discipline and all first year courses of M.Tech Design Engineering are approved.
