Minutes of Meeting

1. Welcome and felicitation of BOS members by the HOD Dr. P. D. Nemade.
2. Introduction of BOS members and all faculties of department of civil engineering were done respectively.
3. Mr. R. C. Patil welcome and introduces all the BOS members.
4. Dr. P. D. Nemade, initiated the meeting and gave the importance and objective of BOS meeting and gave presentation of the civil engineering department. In addition, the incorporation was done in the course of Engineering Mechanics curriculum and content of F Y B Tech.
5. Dr. S. M. Waysal took care of all the presentation and hospitality arrangements.
6. The meeting started at 11.10 AM sharp.
7. Dr. S. J. Kadbhane (Co-ordinator S. Y. B. Tech Civil) gives a presentation on the U.G. S.Y. B.Tech, Civil course structure and shown the curriculum of each course by respective Course Incharge.
8. For BTAP Dr. D. D. Sarode added the following suggestions such as adding content related to Floating FSI, CRZ, RERA and arrange visit to various types of buildings including green buildings.



9. For Fluid Mechanics Dr. D. D. Sarode suggested to add introduction to CFD and plumbing system and Dr. S. J. Wagh suggested to visit the nearby hydraulic structure and related pumps and turbine for better understanding
10. For Mechanics of Structure Dr. D. D. Sarode suggested the addition of influence line diagram (ILD)
11. For Construction Materials and Earth Sciences, Dr. D. D. Sarode and Dr. S. B. Thakare suggested adding practicals and content related to construction material or else change the name of course.
12. For Software and Techniques in Civil Engineering, it was recommended by Mr. Sagar Gangurde to add prerequisite subjects related to basic civil engineering and drawing at F.Y. B.Tech Civil.
13. For soil mechanics and foundation engineering, it was recommended by Dr. D. D. Sarode and Dr. S. J. Wagh suggested that the units be arranged in a chronology, with a reduction in contents as compared to the credits given, elaborate the names of practicals to be performed in the laboratory the field visit to different types of foundations of various civil engineering structures. The name of subject may change to Geotechnical Engineering.
14. All BOS members recommended that Concrete Technology being the most important subject in civil engineering should be incorporated in the curriculum.
15. For Structural Analysis, gone through the curriculum and approved.
16. For Surveying and Geomatics Dr. D. D. Sarode suggested the reduction in the content of the course and Mr. Murli Iyer suggested to incorporate Advance Techniques used in surveying.
17. For Project Based Learning it was suggested by all the BOS members that the concept of PBL should be made clear to students and a separate session for the same should be arranged.
18. Open Elective and Multi-Disciplinary Minor (MDM) basket was discussed thoroughly and got approved.
19. Exit Policy of U.G. F.Y and S.Y. B.Tech discussed in detail and got approved.



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20. The first session of meeting ended at 12.45 PM and the committee headed for lunch and the meeting resumed at 1.20 PM
21. Dr. M. C. Aher gave a presentation on the P.G. F. Y and S.Y. M.Tech course structure and Exit Policy.
22. The BOS members approved the Course Structure and Exit Policy for P.G. F. Y and S.Y. M.Tech Construction and Management.
23. The meeting got ended at 4.00 PM
