- Alumni Visit by Mr. Swapnil Lande (Batch 2022) (05/06/2026)

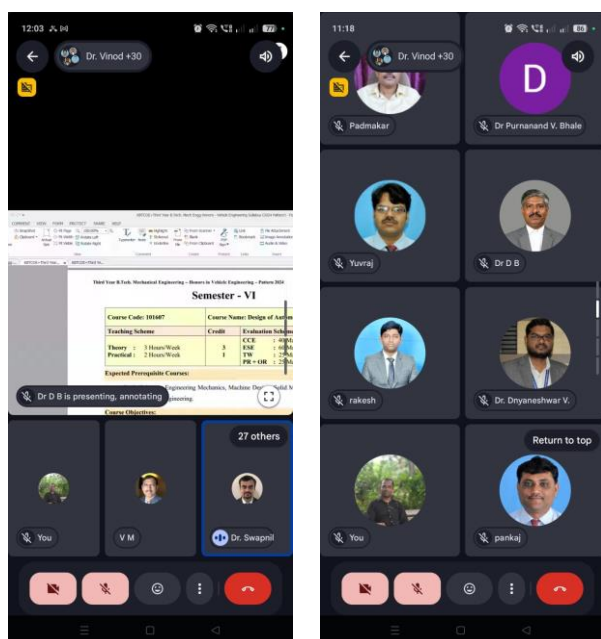

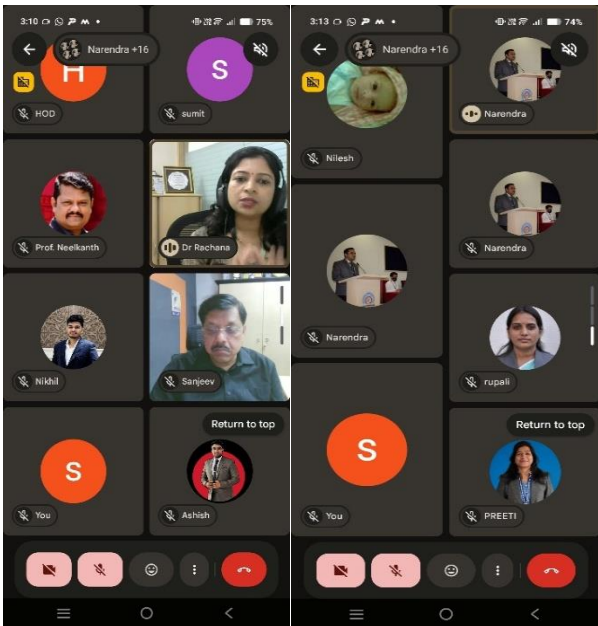
- Board of Studies (BoS – Mechanical Engineering) Meeting (20/06/2026)
