Minutes of the Meeting:

1. Finalization of MBA Second Year (SY) Specializations and Syllabus for A.Y. 2025–26 (Review of 11th January 2025 Meeting):

The board revisited the decisions taken during the BoS Meeting on 11th January 2025 regarding the 07 Specializations under the MBA Program. After receiving internal feedback, employer suggestions, and considering NEP-2020 guidelines, the board reaffirmed and finalized the following specializations:

- a. Marketing Management**
- b. Financial Management**
- c. Human Resource Management**
- d. Operations & Supply Chain Management**
- e. Business Analytics**
- f. Pharma & Healthcare Management**
- g. Agri Business Management**

The **detailed syllabus for Semester III and IV**, including updated elective options, MOOC provisions, and project evaluation rubrics, was reviewed and approved. The board emphasized aligning course content with industry certifications (e.g., Google, NISM, NPTEL) wherever applicable.

2. Discussion and Approval of Syllabus for 'Entrepreneurship, Economics, and Management' (EEM Umbrella) Courses for Second Year Engineering Students:

The board discussed the EEM umbrella initiative intended to develop **entrepreneurial, economic, and managerial acumen** among Second Year

Engineering students. Two **open elective courses** under this umbrella were presented:

a. Entrepreneurship Development

b. Business Economics

These Courses to be designed with practical exposure, including case studies, startup success stories, simulation activities, and economic decision games.

Assessment Structure will include internal components (presentations, assignments, reports etc.) and No end-semester examinations.









The courses will carry **2 credits each**, and shall be integrated in the engineering curriculum from AY 2025-26.
